I am requesting funding for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) for Calumet Region, IN in Fiscal Year 2023.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) – Chicago District, 231 South LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois, 60604.

This funding would be used for construction of water-related infrastructure throughout Lake and Porter Counties. Funding allocated to Calumet Region Environmental Infrastructure provides for partnerships between the USACE and the communities in Lake and Porter Counties, to address critical water, sanitary sewer, stormwater sewer infrastructure improvements designed to alleviate deteriorated conditions within aged infrastructure, increase the efficacy of existing systems, and reverse adverse water quality impacts. Requested funds will allow the Chicago District to continue these partnerships with nonfederal sponsors to address these infrastructure needs.
