9 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The authority to provide edu-10 cational assistance under this chapter shall terminate on 11 August 1, 2028.

"(b) ELIGIBILITY FOR POST-9/11 EDUCATIONAL AS-12 13 SISTANCE.—An individual who is no longer eligible for 14 educational assistance under this chapter pursuant to sub-15 section (a) shall be entitled to educational assistance 16 under chapter 33 of this title in the same manner as if 17the individual had elected to receive educational assistance 18under section 3327 of this title, notwithstanding the re-19 strictions on crediting service under section 3322(h)(1) of 20this title, but subject to the limitations under section 213327(d)(2) of this title.".
